Come and play Thursday, February 11th at 6:30 for a romantic food and wine pairing sure to kick off your valentine's weekend.

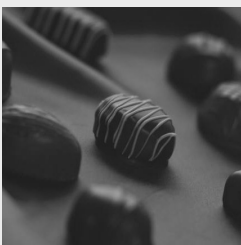
The theme will be romantic Foods and Wine and will be most fun as well as decadent.
